

PROCEDURES FOR CONDUCTING THE VIRTUAL TALENT HUNT

A. SUMMARY

- 1. Students will submit a pre-recorded video for auditioning to Psi Xi Chapter by March 12, 2021.
- 2. The Chapter determines which students compete in the local program.
- 3. Once videos are collected, the local chapter Talent Hunt Committee will compile and conduct the adjudication process per the guidelines.
- 4. No video will be returned.
- 5. All entries (applications and video) due by March 12, 2021.

B. VIRTUAL ADJUDICATION

1. The adjudicators will be convened using Zoom to review the selected videos and determine the winners. This will be done prior to the virtual Talent Hunt Program.

C. VIRTUAL TALENT HUNT PROGRAM

1. The actual virtual Talent Hunt program viewing for the public will be conducted using Zoom. A master of ceremonies will introduce the category of performance and play the different pre-recorded performances. After all video performances have been completed, the predetermined winners will be announced, and the program concluded.

D. METHODS AND PROCEDURES

1. All applications and videos will be submitted to fundi.legohn@gmail.com in .mp4 or .mov via a shared type drive (Google, Dropbox, etc.), as video submission files may be too large to send via email.

E. VIDEO SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The contestants must submit their videos in .mp4 or .mov format only and must be at least 1080p (1920 x1080) resolution and contain the contestant's name. (e.g., mikesmith.mov)
- 2. The videos cannot contain any special effects to enhance their performance.
- 3. The contestants must provide a quick introduction (Including their name, age, title of piece, etc.) prior to their performances and not more than 15 seconds.
- 4. The contestant's environment should have sufficient lighting and appropriate scenery without a busy moving background.
- 5. The appropriate attire for the style you're presenting should be adhered to. No jeans, cut off, nor unappropriated attire will be allowed.
- 6. The performance music be memorized and conducted in 6 minutes or less.
- 7. Videos do not need to be professionally recorded.
- 8. Videos made with iPhones or other digital devices are acceptable provided the audio and video are clear and in the proper format.
